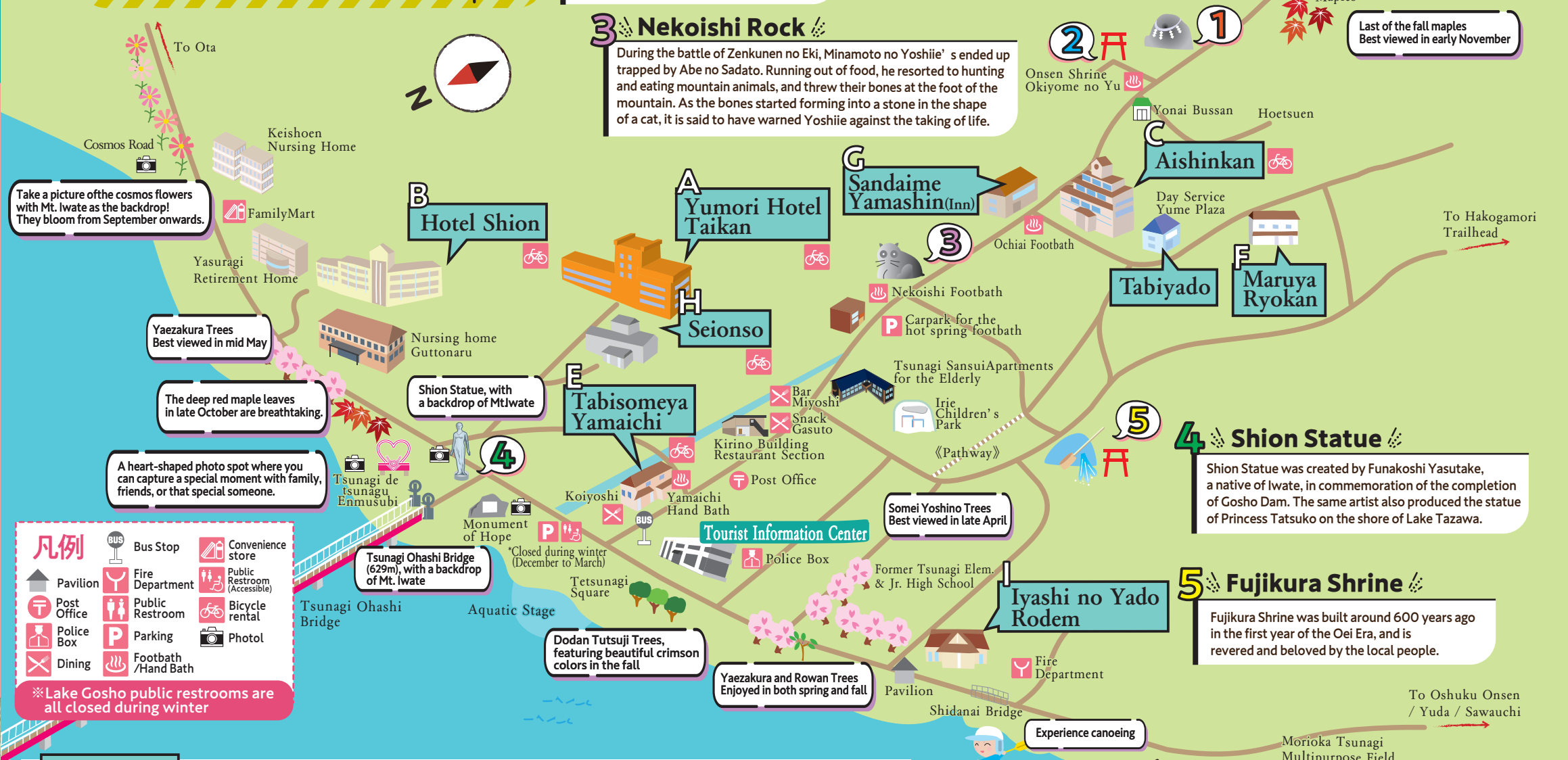

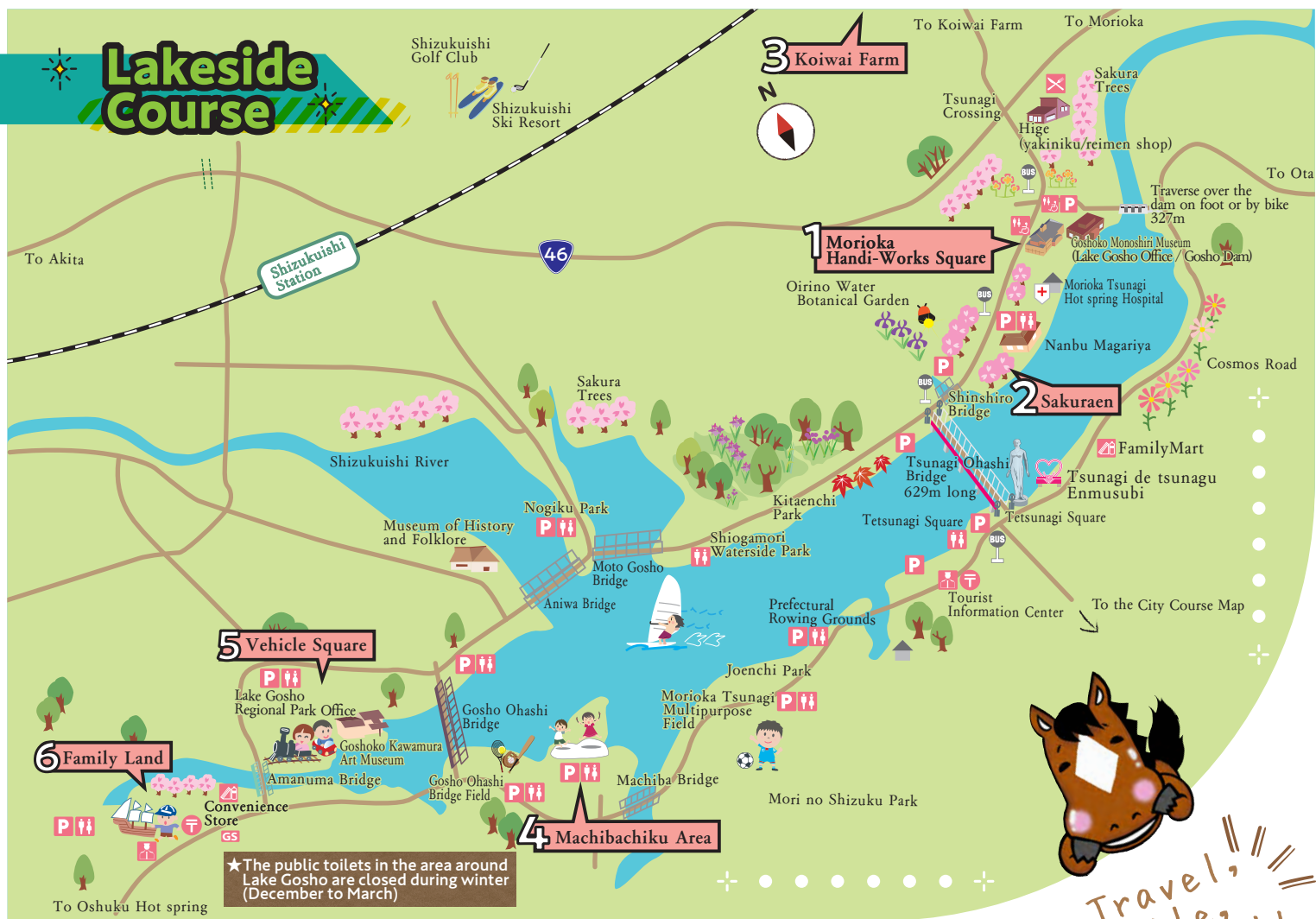

1 Morioka Handi-Works Square

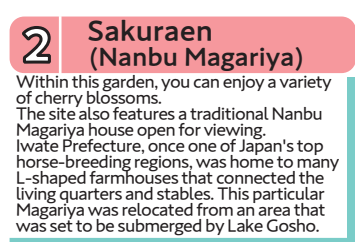
2 Sakuraen (Nambu Magariya)

Within this garden, you can enjoy a variety of cherry blossoms. The site also features a traditional Nambu Magariya house open for viewing. Iwate Prefecture, once one of Japan's top horse-breeding regions, was home to many L-shaped farmhouses that connected the living quarters and stables. This particular Magariya was relocated from an area that was set to be submerged by Lake Goshō.

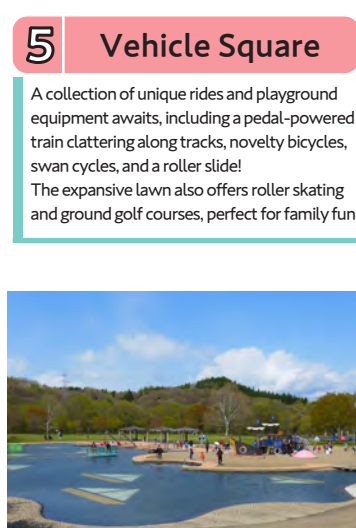
3 Koiwai Farm
